

## Algebraic Expressions Simplifying Expressions Using Properties

Remember learning about properties like Associative, Commutative, Distributive, Identity, and Inverse? These properties are very useful when simplifying algebraic expressions. Let's look at how we can use them to simplify expressions.

When we simplify the algebraic expression  $3x + 5x + 2x$ , we are actually adding the three terms. Using the Distributive Property and the Identity Property, we can factor out the common factor of  $x$  from all three terms to get  $(3+5+2)x$ . This means that we are applying the Distributive Property to the expression  $3x + 5x + 2x$ .

Another property that helps us simplify expressions is the Commutative Property. It states that the order of addition or multiplication does not matter. For example, if we have the expression  $3x + 5x + 2x$ , we can rearrange the terms to  $2x + 3x + 5x$  and still get the same result.

Let's look at another example. Suppose we have the expression  $4(2x + 3) + 5x$ . We can use the Distributive Property to simplify this expression by distributing the 4 into the parentheses.

1. Distribute the 4 into the parentheses:  $4(2x + 3) + 5x = 8x + 12 + 5x$

$$4(2x + 3) + 5x = 8x + 12 + 5x$$

2. Combine like terms:

$$8x + 12 + 5x = 13x + 12$$




